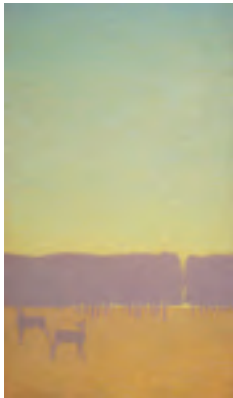

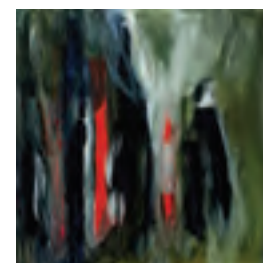

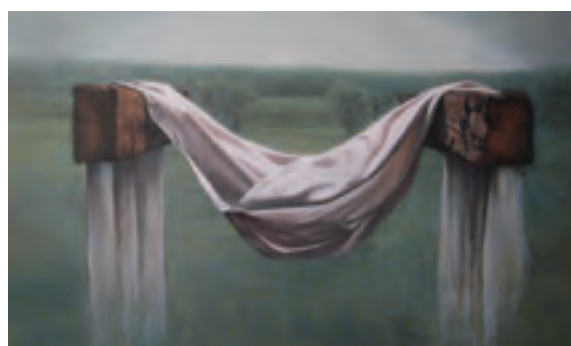

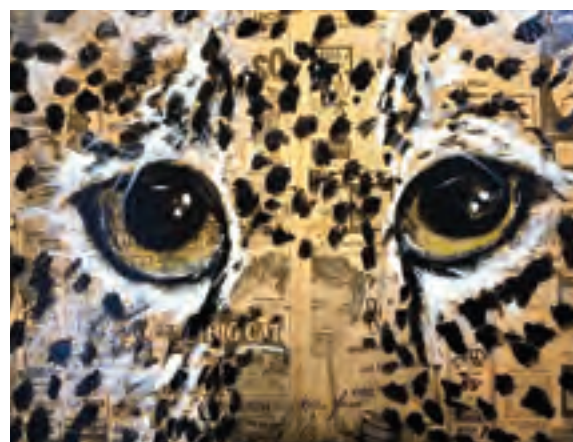

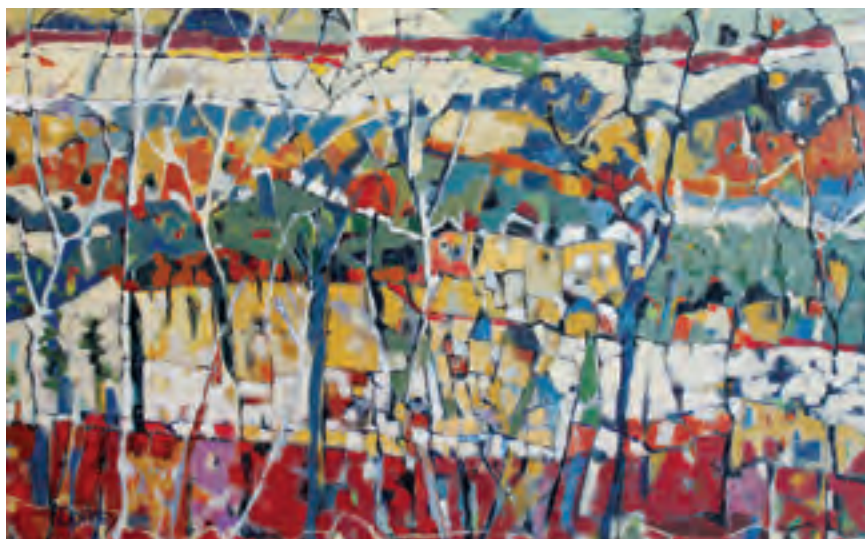

HORSESHOE FALLS

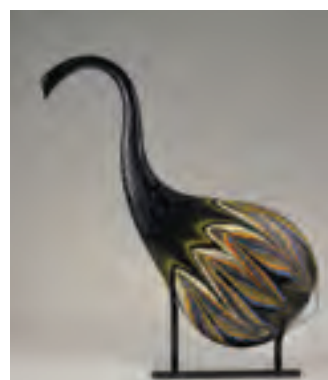

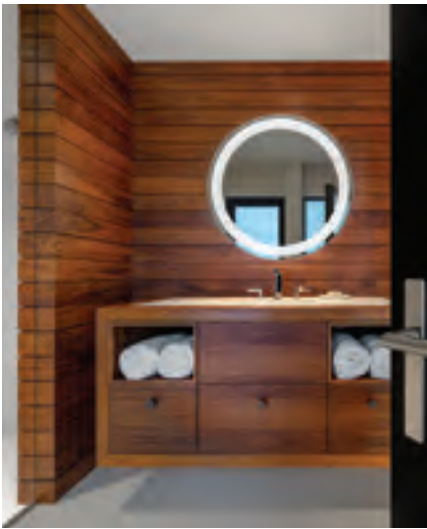
